Invitation to participate in BWF/BEC Coach Education Level 1 Course.

Dear Members,

Badminton Europe is happy to announce the dates and place for the BWF/BEC Coach Education Level 1 Course.

The BWF/BEC Coach Education Level 1 Course will be organised in Oviedo, (Spain) from 27 to 30 April 2023, in close cooperation with the Spanish Badminton Federation. The course is also open to coaches who work with Para badminton players.

1. Planning

The course will be held from Thursday, 27 April 2023 (start at 9:00) to Sunday, 30 April 2023 (finish at 13:00).

2. Participants

Participants are expected to arrive on Wednesday, 26 April 2023 and depart on Sunday, 30 April 2023. Please, do not book any flight tickets on 30 April 2023 before 16:00. Local transport from the airport to the accommodation and from the accommodation to the airport will be arranged by the host.

Airport where participants and tutors will be picked up is **Asturias Airport (OVD). Address:** AI-82, 33459 Santiago del Monte, Asturias, Spain.

3. Services provided and entry fee

Badminton Europe will cover the following for up to 2 participants from each Member.

- Accommodation for 4 nights in a single room, including breakfast.
- Residence Aller : C. Aller, 33006 Oviedo, Asturias, Spain
- Lunch and dinner on site from 27-30 April 2023 (dinners on Wednesday 26 April and Sunday 30 April are not included).

Entry fee: 300€ per participant.

Travel costs for participants will not be covered by Badminton Europe. Travel related costs have to be covered by Members or participants



4. Gender Equity

Gender Equity in badminton constitutes a key subject for both BEC and BWF. Both BEC's terms of reference and BWF's statutes aim to achieve a balanced gender representation in all badminton activities. To achieve this general objective, Members are encouraged to work together with BEC to attract more participants from underrepresented genders in all funded Shuttle Time activities. As a general target, there should be a minimum of 30% of participants of each gender.

5. Registration

All candidates' applications must be submitted by their National Federations via the online link: **BWF/BEC Coach Education Level 1 Course Online Registration**

Be aware that candidates' CV in English must be attached within the online registration.

The deadline for the application is Friday 17 March 2023.

Badminton Europe will review the applications and CVs submitted and will confirm to the Members the final candidates selected. BEC will evaluate the English level of the candidates to make sure the candidates can deliver tasks at an appropriate level.

Please do not make any travel arrangements before receiving confirmation from Badminton Europe.

Additional details about the venue and other arrangements will be communicated closer to the course.
